This grant provided critical support for technical inputs to ensure sound economic analysis and rationale for the additional financing to the West Africa Regional Fisheries Program, for a fishing harbor/landing site in Monrovia, Liberia and Freetown, Sierra Leone. Key lessons learned included the importance of a sound environmental and social assessment up front, securing legally accepted proof of Government ownership of the landing sites at the outset, and putting in place a framework for public-private partnership as part of preparation.

Comment

Outcome of the grant was approval of additional financing to the West Africa Regional Fisheries Program from the ACGF, in terms of \$10 million to Liberia and Sierra Leone Governments. Thus the work of the grant will be sustained through this additional financing.

Bank Performance: Rated Satisfactory

Comment:

Bank performance was satisfactory, in achieving the objective of the grant.

Additional Assessment

Development / strengthening of institutions: Rated Not Applicable

Comment:

This grant was focused on preparation of additional financing, and was executed by the World Bank - thus not focused on institutional development.

Mobilization of other resources: Rated Substantial

Comment:

The grant leveraged \$10 million in additional financing to the West Africa Regional Fisheries Program from the ACGF.

Knowledge exchange: Rated Not Applicable

Comment:

The grant was focused on preparation of an additional financing investment, not knowledge exchange. The additional financing will include knowledge exchange.

Client's policy / program implementation: Rated Substantial

Comment:

The additional financing resulting from this grant, will have a substanital impact on the policies of Liberia and Sierra Leone.

Efficiency: Rated Satisfactory

Comment:

The grant achieved its objectives, for less resources than originally envisaged.

Replicability: Rated Likely

Comment:

The grant prepared investments in fish landing site infrastructure, tied to fisheries governance reforms, that could be replicated throughout other countries participating in the West Africa Regional Fisheries Program.

Main recommendations to stakeholders:

This grant helped to prepare a public sector investment in fish landing infrastructure in Sierra Leone and Liberia. The grant and subsequent infrastructure, will be contingent on the implementation of parallel governance reforms (financed by the West Africa Regional Fisheries Program) to control access to the fisheries in these countries, and reduce over exploitation of the resources. In the absence of a sound governance framework for the fisheries, such infrastructure investments would be inadvisable.

Main recommendations to Bank Management:

This grant provided valuable supplemental resources for preparation of an investment. There is currently no effective instrument for financing preparation of regional investments aside from an advance from a credit or loan of one country. More flexible preparation mechanisms, and even more so in concept development upstream, would be desirable - in order to obviate the need for these types of grants.
