#### **OVERVIEW**

# **Overall Assessments and Ratings**

#### **Grant Objectives:**

Contribute to the conservation of Liberia#s globally significant biodiversity providing better representation of ecosystems within Liberia#s current protected area network and enabling active conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity with local communities.

## Overall progress from 07/01/2014 to 06/30/2015 with regard to Achieving Grant Objectives:

#### Comment:

The project has completed its key activities despite the limitations owing to the Ebola outbreak where the FDA staff and the contractors had limited access to the sites and caused delay.

This MSP project provided the continuum to activities of the previous GEF financed project Consolidation of Liberia Protected Area Network (COPAN) (P105830 #closed in November 2012), which has initiated the support to some protected areas. Attached is the AM for MTR mission

This is progress GRM covering 7/1/2014 to 6/30/2015. The project closed on 6/30/2015 and the completion GRM will be prepared as soon as the client completion report is completed.

#### Overall progress from 07/01/2014 to 06/30/2015 with regard to Implementation of Grant Financed Activities:

#### Comment:

Component 1 Strengthening of the Forestry Development Authority Conservation Department: The project supported capacity development of FDA conducting various training, including FDA forest guards in service training conducted in Lofa County in April 2015. The project also supported construction of Lake Piso Multiple Use Reserve headquarters office for the capacity development at the regional level, and its construction completed in June 2015.

Component 2 Creation of New Protected Areas and Community Mapping: The project supported hiring a consultant to develop gazzetment package for Gola Forest to be marked as Protected Area. The Gola gazzetment package is at the legislature currently awaiting approval, which has been delayed than earlier anticipated. The project also contributed in the gazzetment process for Grebo Forest and Wonegizi Forest to be Protected Area by financing biodiversity study and socio-economic study in these proposed protected areas. During preparation of Gola gazzetment package, community requested to have traditional activity to relocate sacred bush, which was within the proposed protected area. and was supported by the project. This activity was not planned initially and but was considered one of the critical activities in order to have Gola to be gazzetted.

Component 3 Development of Community Livelihood Program around Protected Areas: The project contributed in providing support of livelihood improvement for 14 communities; 6 communities around Gola Proposed Protected Area, 4 communities around Lake Piso Multiple Use Reserve Protected Area, and 4 communities around Wonegizi Proposed Protected Area.

# Grant follow-up and structure

#### Description and context of Grant:

The project is well recognized by the counterpart and also communities. The gazzetment process is not easy, because it requires clarification in land ownership, alternative livelihood, benefits to communities, infrastructure development, etc. The project implementation agency Forestry Development Authority (FDA) has been conducting good consultations from various levels.

Expected follow up (if any): Follow up Bank project/loan/credit/grant

#### Comment on follow up:

The Liberia Forest Sector Project (P154114) is currently under preparation, based on the lessons emanating from this project (EXPAN). The new project is expected to allow continued support to the FDA and to some activities which were already initiated through EXPAN, such as gazzetment process for Grebo National Park in South East and Wonegizi in North West.

#### OUTCOME

#### Comments on outcome achieved from 07/01/2014 to 06/30/2015

Forest Development Authority Conservation Department (FDA-CD) has conducted capacity development training for rangers in all the protected areas and the proposed protected areas. Because the capacity of FDA-CD has gradually developed through the project, now FDA-CD could take initiative in designing training program and having logistics arrangements.

Construction of the FDA headquarters at Lake Piso Multiple Use Reserve has been delayed because the contractor could not go to the site because of Ebola outbreak. However, the construction has restarted in February 2015 and completed. When the Bank implementation support mission team visited the site in June 2015, there were water puddles but the contractor paved the areas afterwards.

Draft gazzetment package for Gola was developed in March 2015 but it is taking long for legislature to approve it despite there is close follow up and immediate actions from FDA side.

When the project was planned, previous GEF financed project Consolidation of Liberia Protected Area Network (COPAN) (P105830, 05/27/2008 #11/30/2012) was expected to complete as planned. However, some activities of COPAN could not complete within its project period, therefore this project was designed to continue remaining activities and other new activities.

The project continued capacity development of FDA. FDA staffs including Protected Areas wardens and rangers received training in Wildlife, Protected Areas management, rangers monitoring. FDA office in Monrovia, Lake Piso, Gola, Wonegizi and Grebo received support in having adequate equipment. The project also contributed in developing the wildlife conservation law#s regulatory framework, a Protected Areas Sustainable Financing Plan and a Protected Area System Management Strategy.

The project continued gazzetment process for Gola Protected Area, which was initiated through COPAN. The Gola gazzetment package is finalized and it is already submitted to legislature to be legalized.

Gazzetment process for Grebo and Wonegizi is on the way. The biodiversity study and socio-economic study in Grebo and Wonegizi, which are part of gazzetment process has been completed.

An act to establish the Lake Piso Basin Multiple Sustainable Use Reserve was adopted in 07/21/2011, but the boundary of the area was not clear. Therefore, the project contributed in activity to mark the boundaries. This is one of the key activities to have keep the protected area

The project contributed in providing biodiversity friendly sustainable activities to the communities around protected areas. Overall 6 communities around Gola Proposed Protected Area, 4 communities around Lake Piso Multiple Use Reserve Protected Area, and 4 communities around Wonegizi Proposed Protected Area were involved in biodiversity friendly sustainable activities.

# Comment on component implementation progress

Implementation of the project has delayed during Ebola outbreak because contractors could not go to the forest communities and also community consultations have been restricted. As Ebola cases decreased in early 2015, the project caught up the implementation, such as completing the construction of Lake Piso Multiple Use Reserve.
