The objective of the Project is to improve the technical capacity of Chiang Mai Municipality for sustainable urban transport development, through technical support to integrated land use and sustainable urban transport planning and pilot demonstration of non-motorized transport improvement.

Comment:

The overall project implementation performance is moderately satisfactory, as it has helped improving the capacity of Chiang Mai Municipality for sustainable urban transport development. There are several follow-on initiatives by the municipality, such as extended bicycle lanes program and the tricycle tourism program in the city center around the project area. The urban transport planning has been done through the project, but the implementation of the plan will take time.

Comment:

Overall project implementation is moderately satisfactory. The consultancies involved technical reports, a series of consultations, and workshop with local communities and stakeholders to get their comments and to create mutual understanding on the project's objectives. Given that many communities nearby the pilot site provide a lot of attention to this project, additional consultations to disseminate the information were requested. This causes some delay to the project implementation, especially on the civil work (component 2). Both consultancy and civil works were completed just before the closing date of March 31, 2014.
