1. **Definitions**

Regional classification: To obtain a comprehensive and reasonable geographical classification for analytical purposes, the mid-term review used different sources of classifications, since the classifications normally used do not covers all the GEF eligible countries in a consistent manner. For example, the GEF uses only four regions for project classification (without Middle East and North Africa (World Bank) or Arab States (UNDP)), but with many more classification categories for constituencies. The WB uses six regions (splitting Asia into South Asia; East Asia & Pacific) whereas the GEF constituency classification splits Asia and The Pacific. Several countries that have not benefitted from past support had not yet been classification combines the five WB geographic regions with eight constituency classification from the GEF:

- Sub-Saharan Africa region, split into constituencies of East & South Africa and of West & Central Africa
- Middle East and North Africa region (MENA)
- Latin America the Caribbean (LAC) region, split into constituencies of Latin America and of The Caribbean
- Europe and Central Asia region(called "Europe" or ECA)
- Asia region, split into constituencies of Asia and of The Pacific

See **Table 6**: Overview of categories of classifications by country classified by constituency.

Income group: Classified for all World Bank member economies, and all other economies with populations of more than 30,000, divided among income groups according to 2007 gross national income (GNI) per capita, calculated using the World Bank Atlas method. The groups are:

- Low income, \$935 US\$ per capita or less
- Lower middle income, US\$936–3,705
- Upper middle income, US\$3,706–11,455;
- US\$745 for LDCs.
- Information is not available for 4 Pacific states.

Least Developed Country (LDC) is classified based on criteria from the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (2003):

- a low-income criterion, based on a three-year average estimate of the gross national income (GNI) per capita (under \$750 for inclusion, above \$900 for graduation);
- a human resource weakness criterion, involving a composite Human Assets Index (HAI) based on indicators of: (a) nutrition; (b) health; (c) education; and (d) adult literacy; and
- an economic vulnerability criterion, involving a composite Economic Vulnerability Index (EVI) based on indicators of: (a) the instability of agricultural production; (b) the instability of exports of goods and services; (c) the economic importance of non-traditional activities (share of manufacturing and modern services in GDP); (d) merchandise export concentration; and (e) the handicap of economic smallness (as measured through the population in logarithm); and the percentage of population displaced by natural disasters.

There are 50 countries in the LDC list (2007/2008) from the United Nations.

Fragile states: Low-income countries scoring 3.2 and below on the Country Policy and Institutional Assessment (CPIA), which is the primary tool used to assess the quality of country policies and the main input to IDA's Performance-Based Allocation (PBA) system (World Bank, 2007). The fragile countries face particularly severe development challenges such as weak institutional capacity, poor governance, political instability, and frequently on-going violence or the legacy effects of past severe conflict.

Heavily Indebted Poor Countries (HIPC): Countries that are only eligible for highly concessional assistance from IDA; develops a Poverty Reduction Strategy Paper (PRSP); and faces unsustainable debt situation after the full the full application of the traditional debt relief mechanisms. A country's debt level is considered unsustainable if debt-to-export levels are above a fixed ratio of 150 percent; or, where countries have very open economies where the exclusive reliance on external indicators may not adequately reflect the fiscal burden of external debt the debt-to-government revenues are above of 250 percent (World Bank). 41 countries are identified, most of them in Sub-Saharan Africa, as potentially eligible to receive debt relief.

<u>Small Islands Developing States</u> (SIDS): The SIDS were first recognized as a distinct group of developing countries at the United Nations Conference on Environment and Development in June 1992. The SIDS includes low-lying coastal countries that share similar sustainable development challenges, including small population, limited resources, remoteness, susceptibility to natural disasters, vulnerability to external shocks, and excessive dependence on international trade. There are 38 UN members and 14 non-UN members in the United Nations' list of SIDS (2007/2008).

<u>Official Development Assistance</u> (ODA) is development aid from the members of development Assistance committee of the OECD to a list of aid recipients (ODA countries), as per the DAC list of ODA recipients.

<u>WB lending category</u>: International Development Association (**IDA**) countries are those that had a per capita income in 2007 of less than \$1,095 and lack the financial ability to borrow from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD). IDA loans are deeply concessional; interest-free loans and grants for programs aimed at boosting economic growth and improving living conditions. **IBRD** loans are noncessional. **Blend** countries are eligible for IDA loans because of their low per capita incomes but are also eligible for IBRD loans because they are financially creditworthy.






Graph 4: RAF allocation distribution by WB lending category




